Study Point: Comparatives, superlatives

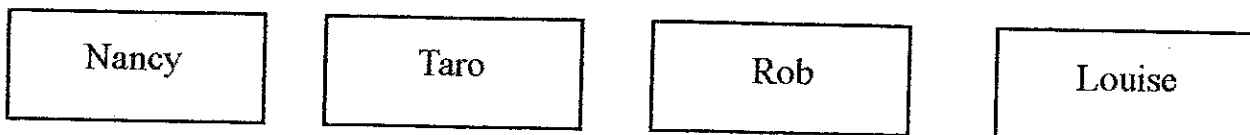

Steps

- ☺ Make six sets of four name cards like this:



- ☺ Divide the class into six groups.
- ☺ Give each group a set of cards.
- ☺ Read four comparative sentences.

Example: Nancy is younger than Taro.
Taro is younger than Rob.
Rob is younger than Nancy.
Louise is the youngest of the four.

- ☺ The students must put the cards in the correct order.
- ☺ Repeat the exercise with a few more adjectives.
